Bears: According to 2001 WAO Tour Guide, the Leslie Road property had **12** North American Black Bears . WAO claimed all bears are products from roadside zoos.
 According to 2001 WAO Tour Guide, the Leslie Road property received **2** Grizzly bears (Tuvey and Pasha) from a circus.
 According to Austinchronicle.com WAO has **16** bears (Feb 6, 2004)
 According to ASUS/WAO web pages, **13** North American Black Bears were retired from research on September 1st, 2004.
 According to Tour Videos 2006 and 2007 - WAO received **2** grizzly bears from Michigan
31 bears were acquired by the WAO from 2004-2006; **3** bears died at Talley Rd from Aug 2004 - Aug 2006
 TP&W Education License recorded **25** bears on 8/7/06; updated permit 3/21/08 recorded **17** bears (12 black bears & 5 grizzly bears)

Wolves: Approximately 2001, WAO received 20+ wolf-hybrids from Sacramento, CA. WAO already had 7 wolves at the Leslie Road property, putting the number of wolves/wolf-hybrids at 27+. An on-line newspaper article, dated 2/6/04 said the WAO had 21 wolves.
 On December 4, 2004, I and a small group of tour members saw 20-30 wolves living in a large enclosure at Talley Road. On 5-15-05, the wolf/wolf hybrid population was reduced to less than 15 wolves living in a smaller enclosure.
 September 2008 - the facility reported having 8 wolf-hybrids.

Chimps: WAO claimed to have 24 chimps at the start of 2006. Ms. Asvestas claimed two chimps died by June 2006. Dr. Ehrulnd conducted an inspection of the Chimps' enclosures in December 2006 and reported only 18 chimps were living at Talley Road.
 Chimp head count revealed 17 chimps in August 2008.
