- HR 2864 - Water Resources Development Act - opposed legislation because it lacked reforms of management practices by the US Army Corps of Engineers to prevent destruction of wetlands and riparian areas
- HR 5018 - Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act - opposed legislation because it lacked international management and enforcement mechanisms to eliminate illegal, unreported, or unregulated fishing that threatens marine fish and wildlife
- HR 4761 - Deep Ocean Energy Resources Act of 2006 - opposed legislation because it lifted a 25-year moratorium on offshore oil and gas drilling and authorized development of biologically sensitive and productive coastal waters
- HR 4200 - Forest Emergency Recovery and Research Act - opposed legislation and supported proposed substitute bills
- National Landscape Conservation System of BLM lands - supported program and Congressional funding
