He criticizes other exotic owners and he supposedly runs a sanctuary that is saving these creatures, but if he kills them I don't see how is he saving them.


This is not the first or second time he threatened to euthanize his animals. How come other places can manage their finances in spite of a hurricane related drop in donations without threatening with mass euthanasia?


