

## **Sample Ethics Pledge for Animal Organizations**

To maintain membership in the organization, all members must pledge to adhere to the following principles and high standards of professional conduct:

## I WILL:

- Conduct myself professionally in a way that reflects well on the organization
- Consider industry's and organization's current and future needs to achieve my goals
- Respect the confidentiality of any information entrusted to me, or obtained in the course of the organization's professional activities
- Consistently educate myself as to the new laws and regulations in the industry.
- Disclose the truth to my donors and supporters
- Be honest when explaining my animal handling experience and background, professional designations, and years of industry experience
- Be truthful by not exaggerating or making up the animal's background stories
- Use rescue, re-home, adopt, sales and educational presentations and advertising materials that are accurate and compliant with local, state and federal regulations
- Refrain from using lies or gossipy remarks about breeders, exhibitors and pet owners, or lie about the origin of the animals in the course of fundraising
- Caring for the animals in the best possible way
- Not acquire more animals than I can properly care for
- Have enough finances to care for the animals owned, even if I am a non profit facility, if donations fail
- Not threaten to euthanize my animals in order to solicit more donations
- Accept the responsibility to protect the animals as well as the public
