HOUSE BILL NO. 1131

- 1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE MISSISSIPPI NON-NATIVE REPTILE
- 2 PROGRAM; TO REQUIRE THE PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE
- 3 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS; TO
- 4 PROVIDE MINIMUM GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAM; AND
- 5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is established the Mississippi
- 8 Non-native Reptile Program to be administered by the Mississippi
- 9 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. The purpose of the
- 10 program is to prohibit the release of non-native reptiles that may
- 11 breed and endanger Mississippi native animal species and citizens.
- 12 (2) The Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and
- 13 Parks shall create rules and regulations to implement such
- 14 programs that, at least:
- 15 (a) Prohibits the release of snakes not found in and
- 16 are not indigenous to Mississippi from being released in the
- 17 state's wildlife;
- 18 (b) Regulates venomous, poisonous and constrictor
- 19 snakes of any kind; and
- 20 (c) Requires a person to report or turn in any snakes
- 21 to the department.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2011.
