It also pressured a state panel on livestock conditions. The Ohio Livestock Care Standards Board on Tuesday reversed an earlier vote and decided to phase out restrictive crates for yeal calves.

That complies with Ohio's agreement with the humane society.

In June, Strickland agreed to a deal with the Humane Society that kept livestock rules off the state ballot last fall.

At present, Ohio is among only a few states with almost no rules in place on exotic animals.
