

Dear Governor and Florida Wildlife Conservation Commissioners, RE: Rule Changes

I have checked the items below that I feel most strongly about. I live next door to a Class I licensee and:

- ☐ I don't think wild animals should be kept captive.
- ☐ I think wild animals should only be in the wild or accredited zoos or accredited sanctuaries.
- ☐ Big cats should not be kept in residential areas at all.
- ☐ Exotic captive animals should be kept in commercially zoned areas.
- ☐ I am appalled you let people keep wild cats as pets or props.
- ☐ I'm glad you are up-listing cougars and cheetahs so they can't be kept as pets.
- ☐ You should up-list all wild cats to Class I so they cannot be kept as pets.
- ☐ I should be notified before someone brings big cats to my neighborhood.
- ☐ I should be notified immediately in the event of an escape.
- ☐ Anyone who possesses a Class I animal, like a tiger, lion, bear or chimpy should have to post the state required 10,000. bond to cover damage by their animals to people and property.
- ☐ You should NOT create loopholes and exceptions.
- ☐ Tax payers like me shouldn't have to foot the bill for regulating the captive wildlife trade.

Most of your proposed rules changes are good but are still so lax and impossible to enforce that:

☐ My city, county or home owners association should be able to enact more restrictive regulations.

☐ You should include all of the rule changes suggested by Big Cat Rescue.

☐ You should require online registrations so that neighbors know where the dangerous animals are, how many are there, and we should be able to see their inspection reports.
