










Photo Gallery of Wild and Exotic Cats and their Hybrids

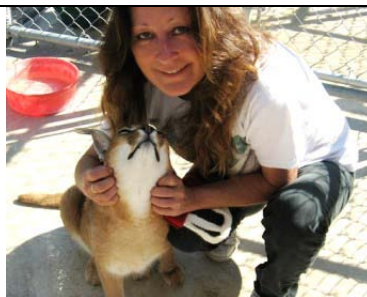

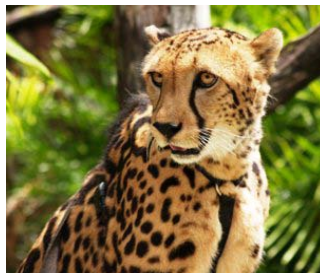

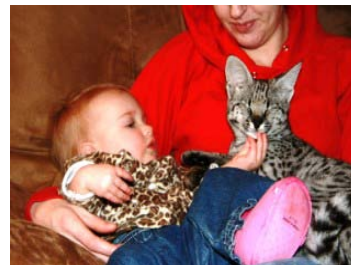
